

THE ACCREDITATION PROCESS FOR THE APPLICATION OF NEW/RENEWAL OF HAND TRAUMA AND REPLANTATION CENTRES

from June 2019

- The Hand Trauma and Replantation Centre (HTRC) makes a request on the FESSH website
- FESSH informs the National Representative and sends a link for the interactive application by email to the Hand Trauma and Replantation Centre.
- 3. The Hand Trauma and Replantation Centre fills out the form and FESSH HTRC office sends the document to the National Representative.
- 4. The National representative checks the data and supports the application
- Normally the Hand Trauma and Replantation Centre will be accredited automatically by FESSH if requisites are satisfied
- Any Hand Trauma and Replantation Centre which does not have the support of the National Representative will be referred to the Hand Trauma Committee.
- 7. Accredited Hand Trauma and Replantation Centres will receive a certificate from FESSH in PDF format and an electronic badge for a 5 years period
- 8. If the applicant unit does not fulfil the criteria to become an HTRC, the unit will be placed on a list of recognized "Hand Trauma Units", provided that it fulfils a minimum of requirements, and will participate in the hand trauma network. The Hand Trauma Units will not be audited and certified by FESSH.

The HTC will make a random choice of 2-4 Hand Trauma and Replantation Centres per year which they will audit along with a national representative.

The accredited Hand Trauma and Replantation Centres will be encouraged to use the FESSH certificate and/or badge in all their communications including the hospital website.
