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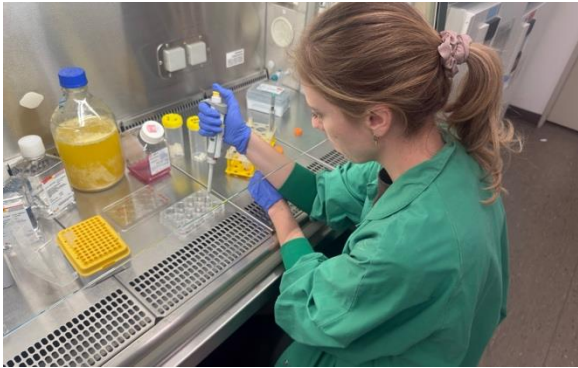
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A unique fellowship experience combining clinical exposure, translational research, innovative surgical education, and international scientific exchange in hand surgery.
